The Calendar Method

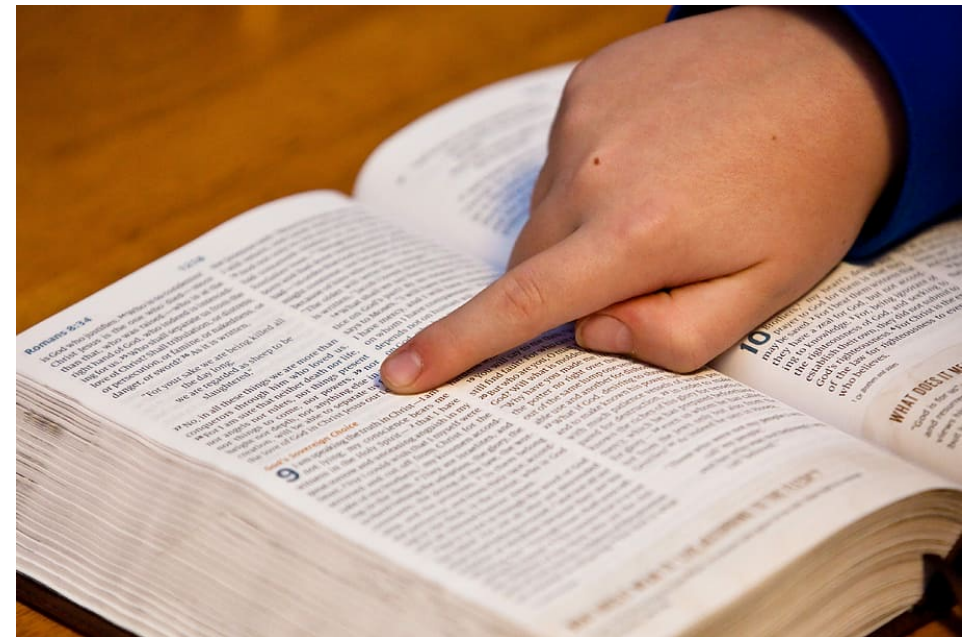
Read a Chapter a Day





The Random, “Pick a Verse”, Method

Matthew 27:5 So Judas threw the money into the Temple. Then he went out and hanged himself...



Luke 10:37 Then said Jesus unto him, Go, and do thou likewise.

Research/Comparison Method

Choose a person, topic or word you wish to learn about.

Look up all the verses that pertain to the subject you chose.

Compare the verses to see how/if they apply to your chosen subject.
